**AUDIENCE:** Basic-Intermediate. May be especially helpful for students, new graduates, technologists returning to blood bank, generalists, or part-time blood bank technologists.

**DRY FORMAT:** Participants will attend a 2-hour webinar workshop at their institution reviewing case material selected by the Illinois community. Cases that describe and illustrate the use of serologic techniques for problem resolution will be presented. The workshop will address problem-solving techniques for antibody identification and ABO/Rh testing, with a focus on investigation of possible delayed hemolytic transfusion reactions, while stressing the importance of assessment of clinical data during the serologic problem-solving process. Time will be allowed for highly encouraged group interaction and discussion.
